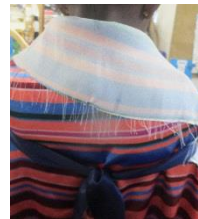

Please note that mobile phones are **not permitted** in the reception, community space, corridors, classrooms, gardens and the Children Centre rooms.

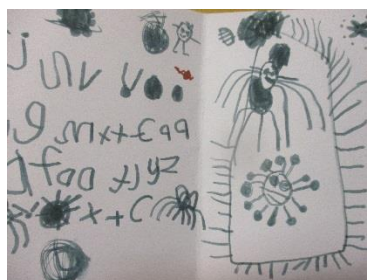
Interactive Story-telling
