Dear Parents / Carers,

Re: Update

The governing body has agreed that Kintore Way Nursery School can begin to welcome more children back to nursery with a gradual approach.

We do have to cap numbers as we can only have small groups of children in each class (bubble).

Next week we are going to have a few children start in each bubble and increase the numbers the following week. We will then know if we can accommodate more children safely.

We are doing our best to accommodate families who want their children to return, we also understand that some parents want to wait a little longer. We are currently contacting parents who answered 'Yes' in the survey to agree a possible start date. Parents and carers will need to confirm they agree our new home/school agreement and provide us with updated emergency contact details prior to children returning.

I have attached some documents that explain how we the nursery will be different and our new procedures.

I have also attached our risk assessment so you understand the measures we are taking to minimise the risk of children and adults spreading COVID-19. I have also included a code of conduct for the children which explains how we would like the children to behave at school. We have provided a booklet that you can share with your child at home.

Many of you will be keeping your children at home, we will continue to provide home learning activities and your child's key person will stay in regular contact with you during this time, some days they will be classed based so may not always answer your emails straight away.

For children who are eligible for free school meals, we will be processing vouchers on Monday morning to cover the period from 1st June to 12th June.
