

Get some paper and some crayons. Turn on the radio and make marks inspired by the music. Have you made small marks? Big marks? Lines? Circles?



Music

Use sand, salt, rice or something that can be reused to make marks in.



Sand



Get a freezer bag and put a small amount of paint, shower gel or cream into it. Seal the bag so that there is very little air in it. I would suggest using cellotape or gaffer tape to seal the top. Place the bag onto a flat surface and create marks and pictures by drawing with your finger.

Playdough



Use tools or your fingers to make marks in playdough.

Explore



Feel like being messy? Use shaving foam or cornflour to make marks in. Tip: do this in a tray and with your sleeves rolled up! Corn flour can be re used so let it dry. When you're finished with it just add water to it to make it gloopy again!

Draw around an object or even a shadow! You can use a torch or a light if there is no sun.
