This could be:


- Reading a story that celebrates Black culture with the children we have many to choose from or you can bring one of your favourites from home.
- Showing the children clothes that you wear on special occasions.
- Showing the children how you style your child's hair what products and accessories you use.
- Playing dominoes with the children or other traditional family games.
- Teaching the children a traditional song.
- Talking to the children about your family history/home-country (show photos or special objects)

Let your child's Key Person know if this is something you in which you would like to take part.

Core Books, Songs and Poems

The children love to share books and stories and we enjoy bringing them to life with props and by acting them out. We share core 2 books this half-term in both the Under 3's classes and the 3-5's classes. Core books are books that we think that the children will really enjoy and that we would like them to know well. We are seeing the children retelling these stories in class. This retelling occurs as the children play with small world toys, in the homecorner and in games in the playground as well as in children's art work. The repeated retelling of these stories supports language and vocabulary consolditation as well as helping children to learn key concepts. We also have fun core songs and rhymes that support language acquisition.

Applying for a Primary School Place

Please find attached Southwark's guide to applying for a primary school place. If your child was born **between September 2018 and August 2019**, your child is due to start primary school in September 2023.

You must apply by Sunday 15th January 2023.

You need to apply online at www.southwark.gov.uk/schoolsadmission

Please try and find 6 schools for your application. Look at schools' websites and contact the schools' offices to find out about open days and visits.

Lots of schools will hold open days from October.
