


#### **CHORUS**



#### Understanding of the World


We used 'Three Little Pigs' as an opportunity to look at properties of different materials.


We will be starting indoor planting and growing - including cress and herbs.


### Science week 10th March - 19th March


#### Exploring Maths - Subitising

Subitising is the ability to recognise a small group of objects without counting. It is a fundamental skill in the development of number sense. We support children to recognise groups of objects up to 3 without having to count by playing lots of number games such as showing fingers and dominoes. Children learned to subitise with different natural materials in the outdoor environment such as twigs, pebbles, leaves and corks
