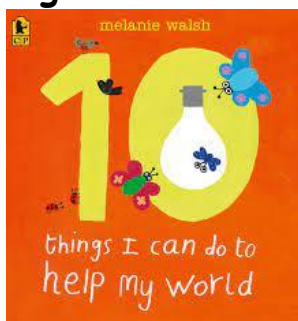


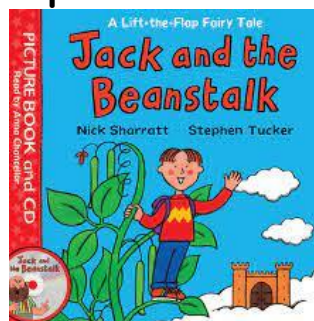

Junk Modelling

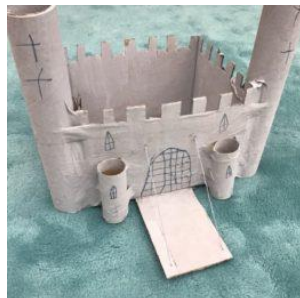
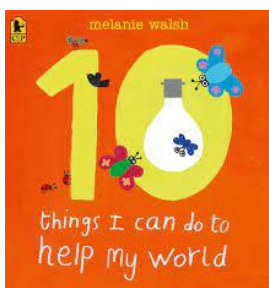
We will further develop our mark-making and cutting skills when making models from recycled materials.



Royal Coronation

To celebrate the Coronation, children and families are invited to a special party where we will plant a plum tree, sing songs and recite some special poems.

Everyone is invited to join in the fun and there will be lots of games to choose from as well as delicious food, cakes and drinks. In the lead up to the Coronation, children will learn about how to care for their environment by reading '10 things I can do to help my world.' They will be planting and using recycled materials for junk modelling. Children will make castles, thrones, crowns, swords, shields to inspire exciting role-play. Children can even choose to tell stories about the King and act out their stories as part of Story-Acting.
