



Relaxed and Happy Learning

Adults are supporting children to feeling happy and relaxed as they play through the day. Children are supported in choosing activities that interest them and adults are playing alongside children.



Children are able to develop their interests as well as share experiences with their friends. Adults play with the children extending their vocabulary and thinking skills and their social skills through modelling and conversation.

Mathematical Development

Adults will be supporting children to be confident in using the nursery toilets. They will be supporting children to wash and dry their hands properly after they have used the toilet and before they eat snack and eat lunch.

Keeping Healthy

Matching and Sorting. The visual memory and discrimination involved and the identification of patterns and relationships and similarity and difference help children to learn about early representation and problem solving.

Matching and sorting activities can also be good for developing fine motor skill.
