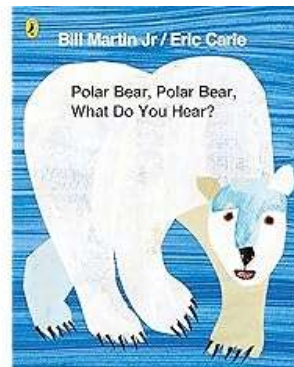


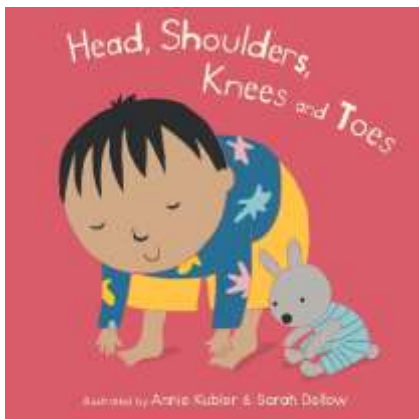

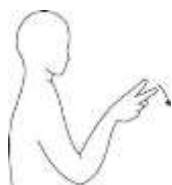
On Bonfire Night

Festivals of Autumn



We continue to enjoy the Autumn Season with the children and will continue to have discussion about changes in weather and in nature. We will also discuss the meaning of important festivals such as Diwali and Bonfire Night. As the days grow shorter, it is an exciting time to think about concepts surrounding light and dark. We will read information books and stories as well as sing songs to enhance meaning. Children will draw from observations and discussions to further explore and create.

Mathematics

Counting

Children can practice counting by counting the things that they see such as toys they are playing with or plates on the table. We can count our fingers or our toes. We can use our finger to point to objects we are counting. Children can count buses or cars that they spot whilst outside. We could also count the number of steps we take. We can make counting fun by clapping, stomping or jumping when counting. There are lots of fun games to play that involve counting such as 'Hide and Seek' or 'What's the time Mr Wolf?' Practice counting by counting to five and then to ten. Practice counting by chanting numbers in sequential order. Why not sing different counting songs?

Phonics

We will have fun listening to and distinguishing between sounds in our environment such as different types of outdoor creatures, vehicles or musical instruments. We will mimic and make up sounds of fireworks using our voices and instruments. We will explore sounds when reading 'Polar Bear, Polar Bear, What Do You Hear?'

We will talk about the importance of building good habits such as eating healthy snacks, brushing our teeth and visiting the dentist. Children will learn how regular brushing keeps our teeth healthy by removing plaque hence preventing cavities as well as maintaining our smiles.
