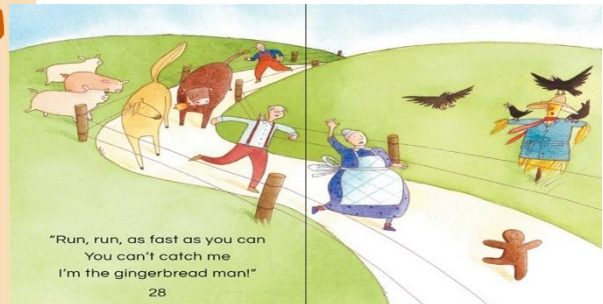

And hide his head under his wing, poor thing.



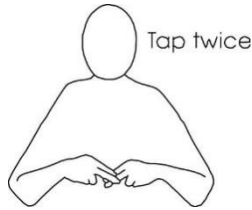
Makaton

We are learning these Makaton signs:

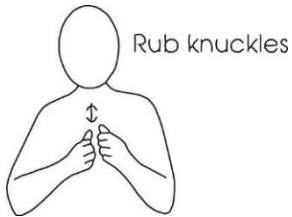
