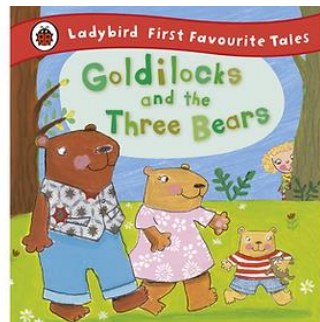

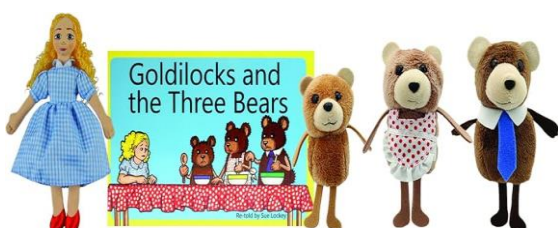

Sharing and Turn Taking



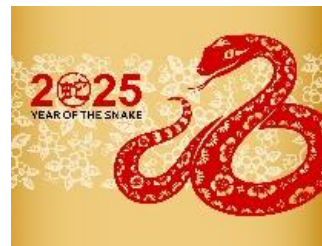
