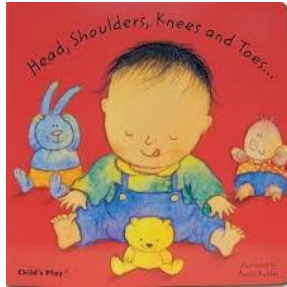


## 2-3s Two Week Learning Block- September 8<sup>th</sup> to September 19<sup>th</sup> 2025

The horn on the bus goes beep, beep, beep

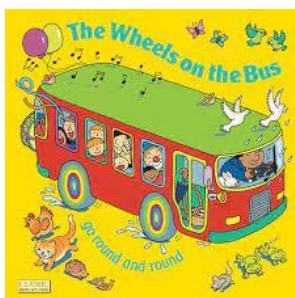
The children on the bus go up and down,

The daddies on the bus go stop that noise,

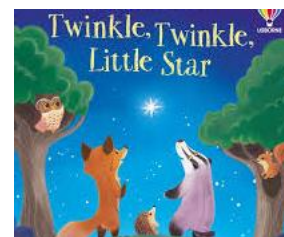
The babies on the bus go wah, wah, wah

and close, open and close.



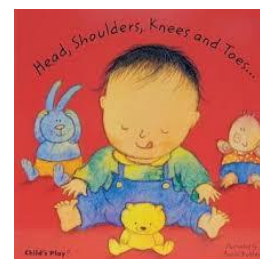
### **Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star**

## Relaxed and Happy Learning

Some children will be starting nursery and so adults will be supporting children to feel happy and relaxed as they play through the day.
