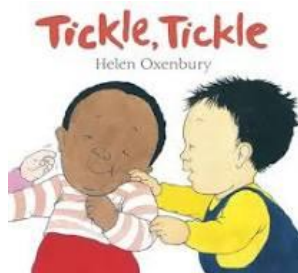

And all three little ducks came swimming back

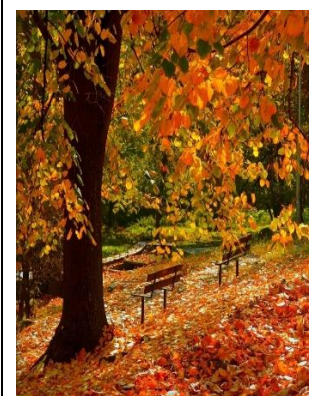
Leaves Are Falling
