Starting Primary School – September 2026

The deadline to apply to start school in September 2026, is 15th January.

You should apply for a place even if your child is currently being assessed for an Education, Health and Care Plan.

If your child already has an Education, Health and Care Plan in place, you do not need to do this because Southwark Council's SEN Team will contact you directly to ask you which schools you would like them to consult with.

Disability Living Allowance

Do you receive Disability Living Allowance [DLA] for your child? The nursery can access a £2,000 payment for every child who receives this benefit to purchase equipment and resources to support the children.

All we need is a copy of your letter stating that your child is entitled to this benefit that we can scan and submit to Southwark Council. If you are happy for us to do this, please bring in your letter and pass it to the office.

If your child does not currently receive DLA but you believe that he or she may be entitled to, please do speak to the office, Julia or Rebecca who can help you find out more.
