


If you're angry and you know it stamp your feet


Row, Row, Row Your Boat

Children will learn to sing song in pairs holding hands to row.

Self Help Skills



Children will learn to wash hands after coming in from the garden, after using the toilet or before having drinks, snack or lunch.

Self-Care

Children will be supported to understand the cold weather and to know that in winter they will wear hats and scarves and mittens and boots. Children will learn to name items of clothing.



Animal Play

Playing with small world animals and puppets and learning to name them and imitate the sounds of the animals. Starting with the animals in the text 'Brown, Bear Brown Bear.' extend to other animals that are familiar to children. Singing 'Old Macdonald' with variety of animals to support this.

Support children's confidence in making sounds that the animals make with 'barrier games.' An animal is hidden behind a blanket and animal recreates the sound the animal makes. Can the children then name the animal and check they are correct when the animal behind the blanket is revealed.

Physical Development

Lots of opportunities for messy play with cornflour and with playdough. Children will strengthen the strength in their hands and their fine motor co-ordinations as they explore with these materials.



Communication and Language

Adults will support children's play with puppets and small world toys and building resources. This interactive play will support language development and friendships with peers.

Adults will support children with sensitive playful interactions inside the class and outside in the garden. Adults will use spoken language, Makaton signing and Communication in Print symbols to support with children's understanding of action words and labelling words. Children will also learn to name feelings such as a happy, sad and angry.

Children to understand action words 'Stop, Go, Stand Up, Sit Down, Walk Run and Jump as they play a variety of group games with their teachers.
