



**Theme - Curiosity - What's your question?**

-Thinking about why bubbles are round, using different bubble wand shapes and even making our own bubble wands




## Shrove Tuesday



To celebrate 'Pancake Day' which was in the Half Term Holiday, we will have pancakes with fruit. Shrove Tuesday, celebrated by Christians in

the run up to Lent is also known by some as Mardi Gras with costumes and parades. How about making pancakes at home using the 1 cup recipe? Crack an egg into a large bowl, add 1 cup of self-raising flour and 1 cup of milk and whisk until you have a smooth batter. Add a drizzle of oil or a knob of butter into a frying pan on medium heat then pour in a ladle spoon of batter, when small bubbles appear flip the pancake over. Serve with fruit.
